Forwarding Etc. Expenses Clause

If owing to circumstances beyond the control of the Assured, an insured voyage is interrupted, frustrated or terminated for any reason whatsoever, including where due to insolvency and/or financial default of the owners, managers, charterers or operators of the vessel, and the cargo insured hereunder is not delivered to the destination contemplated, this insurance is to continue, subject to the original insuring terms, whilst the insured cargo is held in storage (onboard vessel or otherwise), whilst awaiting release and whilst in the course of onward transit to the original or substituted destination. Underwriters shall also pay any additional charges and legal fees which are incidental to the release, storage and/or onward shipment of the insured cargo which are incurred by the Assured.

Expenses recoverable under the above clause shall be subject to a sublimit in addition to any sue and labour or other expenses which may be recoverable elsewhere under this policy.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
