Container Clause

(Registration No.: 09AD2022000210385)

Where shipping containers are provided by third parties, the fitness of the containers for the safe carriage of the subject matter insured is admitted as between the Assured and the Insurer.

To the extent that cover for shortage is provided hereunder, claims for shortage from a sealed container shall not be invalidated by the fact that seals are or appear intact upon arrival. Shortage in this context shall be determined as the difference between the number of packages loaded in accordance with the shipper's or supplier's invoice or packing list and the number of packages removed at the time the container is unloaded.

In respect of goods carried in containers this insurance specifically includes cover against loss and/or damage caused by sweat and/or condensation howsoever, whensoever and wheresoever occurring.

Whenever the word "container" appears herein it shall be deemed to mean "container and/or trailer and/or any other inter-modal method of unit load".

For the purpose of this clause, this Policy includes cover against loss howsoever arising caused by sweating and/or condensation and/or heat damage and/or change in temperature or humidity and/or contamination and/or interruption of power, heat, air-conditioning or refrigeration.
