

Marine/CEAR 50/50 clause

Upon arrival at the final destination, goods are to be inspected by the Insured for possible Damage incurred during transit. In case of packed goods which are to be left in their packing until a later date, the packing is to be visually inspected for signs of possible Damage. If any sign of damage is visible, the goods are to be unpacked immediately and inspected. Any Damage discovered is to be reported to the marine section. Any Damage to the goods which becomes manifest only upon their unpacking will be ascribed to the marine section or the construction/erection section according to whether it clearly was caused before or after arrival of the goods at the Location. Where it is not possible to establish whether the Damage was caused before or after arrival of the goods at the Location, it is agreed that settlement will be made 50/50 by the marine and the erection sections.
